

Are You At Risk For Hepatitis A?



Check any box that applies to you

Work History

- Sanitation worker (sewer worker, sewage treatment worker, plumber)
- Health or institutional care (nurse, nursing aid, home health aid, orderly, cleaning staff, laboratory staff)
- Childcare worker
- Work takes you to countries where hepatitis A is common
- Law enforcement (corrections officers, cleaning staff)
- Other with exposure to human waste

Medical History (have you experienced any of the following?)

- Hemophilia or clotting disorder
- Diagnosed with HIV
- Diagnosed with other sexually transmitted disease
- Have a household member with hepatitis A or with any of the above experiences

Activities

- Household member or sex partner has hepatitis A
- Travel to country where hepatitis A is common
- Anal sex
- Oral-anal sex (rimming)
- Live in institutional setting (such as long-term care, group home)
- Work in or have children in childcare settings
- Inject drugs (including steroids and hormones) with unsterile equipment

**A check in any box indicates possible exposure to the hepatitis A virus.
